General information

Command: `cd`

Description: Use `cd` to change between directories.

Usage: `cd <SpecifyYourPath>`

common options: n.a.

Action: Change your location into the directory specified by `<SpecifyYourPath>`.

Examples

```
cd /
```

action: move into the root directory

```
cd ~
```

action: move into your home directory

```
cd ~ingo
```

action: move into ingo's home directory

```
cd ..
```

action: move one directory up

```
cd /usr/local/bin
```

action: move into the directory bin located at /usr/local/
